EQ-WOOD (European Qualifications for the WOOD and furniture industry) is an Erasmus + Sector Skills Alliance project aimed at supporting the innovation capacity and competitiveness of the European wood and furniture sector, designing and offering to companies, the definition and a multimedia training toolkit for the new figure of the Innovation advisor for the wood-furniture sector.

After the research and study phases to arrive at a common definition of the Innovation Advisor, adapted to the contexts of the different European countries, the professional Curriculum was defined. It is the set of knowledge and skills expected at the end of the training course.

The Innovation Advisor's professional curriculum is divided into 5 areas of fundamental competences. Each Area details the set of skills, knowledge and soft skills objective of the training course and introduces the training tools (methods and contents) necessary to achieve the set objectives.

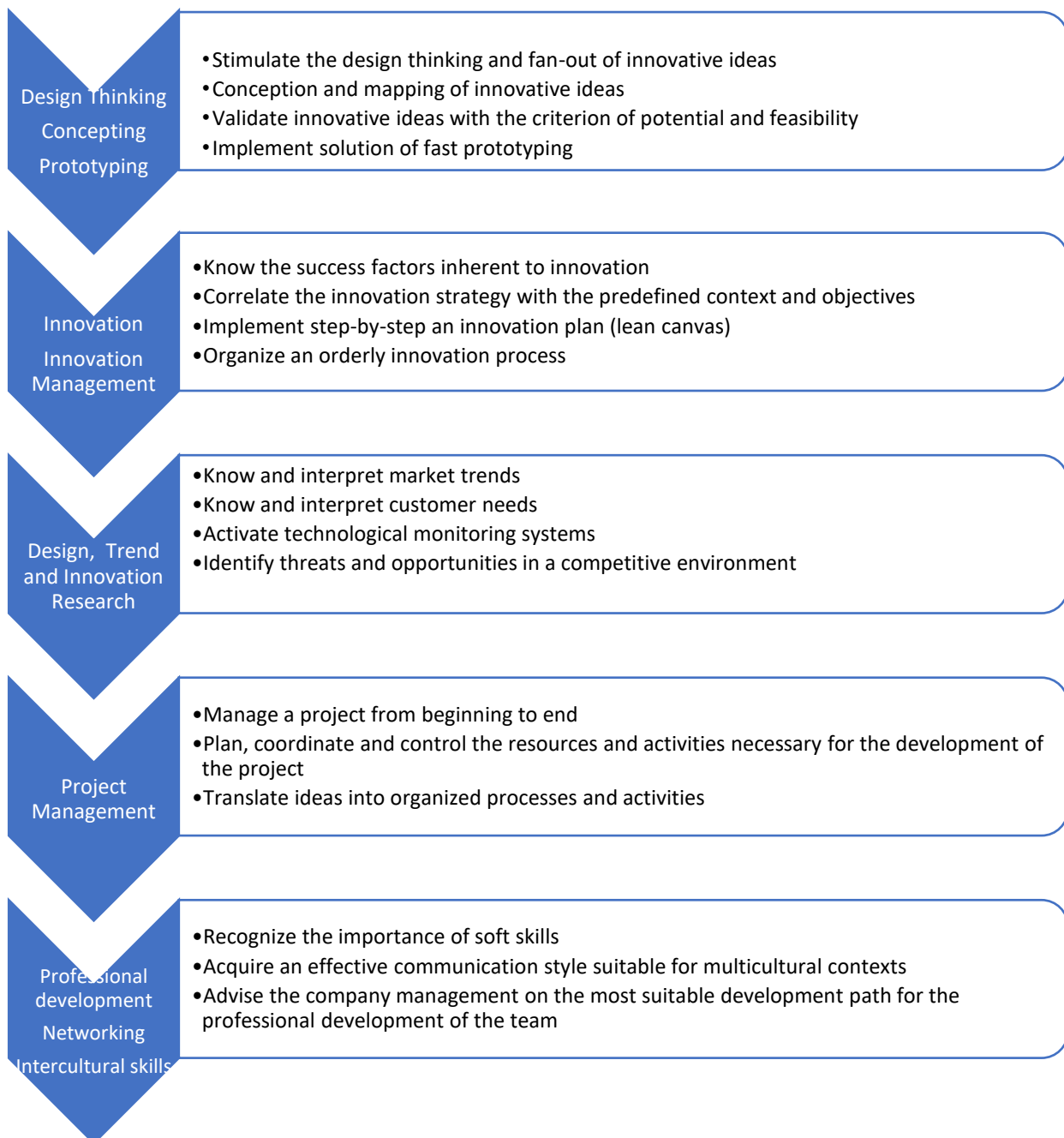
THE CURRICULUM OF INNOVATION ADVISOR CURRICULUM
